

**Bishop Chatard High School
Textbook Rental Program
2009-2010 School Year**

I understand that Bishop Chatard High School supplies assigned textbooks for my student's use during the 2009-2010 school year through a rental cost of \$325.00 per student per family. These rental textbooks (**excludes *Bibles* and *Writing Research Papers***) remain the property of the school. I agree that the textbooks will be returned in good condition to Bishop Chatard High School at the requested time. I further understand that if the assigned textbooks are not returned or not returned in good condition, I will be billed for replacement at the current textbook(s) cost.

Good condition is defined as:

- return of the same assigned textbook as received at the start of the class
- no missing pages
- no missing covers or broken bindings
- no excessive highlighting or handwriting within the text or covers
- no defacement or use beyond recognition
- any other serious or significant damage that would prevent re-renting the textbook for the next school year including but not limited to water damage, stains, other abuses

It is recommended that each student write his/her name on the "property of" form in the front of each textbook and use a book cover on each textbook to help prevent against loss and wear.

Consumable textbooks (workbooks, exam prep books, etc.) are included in the rental fee but additional replacement consumables will be sold at cost to the student if the original book is lost or misplaced. This fee must be payed at time of replacement purchase in the Bookstore. *Bibles* and *Writing Research Papers* books must be purchased directly in the Bookstore and are not included in the rental agreement.
