

BISHOP CHATARD HIGH SCHOOL PARENT TRINITY CLUB COMMITTEE DESCRIPTIONS

Campus Ministry: This committee will work with the campus ministry office at Bishop Chatard to help as needed. This may include organizing meals and snacks for retreats and making reminder telephone calls when needed.

Chaperones: Volunteers provide supervision for one or more school dances including Homecoming, Christmas, and the Turn-About Dance. Chaperon coordinators are needed for each dance, which includes communicating with the administration and dance volunteers, and making phone calls.

Chatard-A-Bration: Committee members will work throughout the year to plan and organize the annual Chatard-A-Bration, which is the school's largest fundraising event. There are a variety of opportunities to volunteer, including auction solicitations, decorations, set-up, registration, clean-up, etc.

Christmas Luncheon: This committee plans and provides a Christmas luncheon for the Bishop Chatard staff in December. This is a good committee to sign up for if you do not have a lot of extra time to volunteer, but would like to donate food for the lunch. If you sign up, you will receive a call from the committee asking you to send in a needed item.

Concession Stand: Volunteers needed to work concession stand during athletic events and other school functions. Volunteers will be needed approximately three times during the year for a two hour shifts.

Dance Marathon: This committee will plan and organize the food and volunteers for the annual Dance Marathon benefiting Riley Hospital for Children, which will be held in October. Please sign up if you would like to donate food or help volunteer on the day of the event.

Graduation Events: This committee plans and provides volunteers for the Baccalaureate dinner and organizes volunteers to work at graduation. Traditionally, junior parents serve on this committee.

Open House: This committee provides volunteers during our open house in November. This includes set up, registration, tours, and providing refreshments.

Outreach/Prayer: This committee organizes prayer services when needed for members of our community due to tragedy or illness. The committee also sends cards and flowers to members of the Bishop Chatard community as needed. The outreach/prayer committee hosts a regular prayer time in the chapel at BCHS for parents to pray together.

Post-Prom: Committee members plan, organize, and provide an after-prom party for our junior and senior students. Junior parents are strongly encouraged to participate in this activity.

Progress Report Dinners: This committee organizes and provides dinner for the Bishop Chatard staff before each Progress Report Night. This is another good opportunity for parents who would like to volunteer by sending in a needed food item.

Receptions: This committee organizes and provides a reception at Back to School Night (September), the Living Rosary (October), and Honors Night (May).

School Volunteers: The committee provides volunteers throughout the year as needed. This committee may include help with school mailings, working at registration, book return, and elsewhere when requested by school administration.

Social Events: This committee organizes social activities for the Bishop Chatard parents such as the Freshman Moms Dessert and the annual Chicago Bus Trip.

Staff Appreciation & Teacher Appreciation Week: Committee members organize monthly treats for the Bishop Chatard staff. You may sign up to help plan for each month or volunteer to send in items when needed. During Teacher Appreciation Week, the committee will plan special ways to thank our teachers with treats.

Used Uniform Sale: This committee will help organize the annual Used Uniform Sale held in June. This includes collecting and sorting of the uniforms and planning and working the actual sale night.

Walk-A-Thon: This committee organizes the volunteers needed for the Walk-A-Thon held in April.
