Minutes from the Music Booster Meeting of September 8<sup>th</sup>, 2011

The meeting was called to order by Dan Haag at 7:10. Hand outs of by-laws and an agenda for the evening were distributed and the by-laws for forming a Booster Club were reviewed by all attending. Dan called for any changes to the by-laws and 2 were made. Decisions made by unanimous vote were changed to a 2/3 majority. The process for removal of a board member was changed to include a special election by board members. Dan asked for a vote to approve the by-laws with the changes made and a unanimous vote was taken.

A vote at next month's meeting will determine board members. Anyone wishing to be on the ballot should contact Dan Haag.

Currently the Booster account has a balance of \$0.00 and while the primary purpose of the Booster Club is NOT to raise money, money is needed for special needs. We have opportunities to raise money by working concessions for the CYO games on Sept. 11<sup>th</sup>, Oct 2<sup>nd</sup> and Oct 23<sup>rd</sup>. shifts run from noon to 1:30 and 1:30 to 3:00. 2-3 workers are needed per shift and at least one has to be an adult. All fundraisers will go through the Booster club account. Ideas to bolster the account were also taken and sponsoring a couple jeans days was considered to be the best option at this early time. Other ideas were to work concessions at a Colts game or handing out programs at a Colts game and holding a bake sale.

Angela Peterson, Choir Director, brought up a subject that needed consideration. The choir was asked to sing the National Anthem at a Butler men's Basketball game. However in order to do so, Butler requires the choir to sell 50 tickets at a cost of \$16, \$12 or \$7 depending on age and seating location. A deposit of \$100.00 is needed to hold the date. Angela asked the group if they thought the venture to be worthwhile pursuing and most thought it would be. Available dates are in November (too close with no money in the account) and 2/14 and 2/21 both Tuesdays. Your thoughts are welcome on the selling of the tickets.

Dan and Angela thanked everyone for their participation and the meeting was dismissed at 8:00.
