

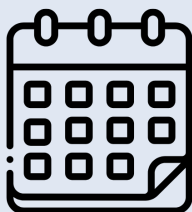

Q2 midterm grades were sent on Tuesday, November 19. Please reach out to your student's teacher with any questions or concerns.

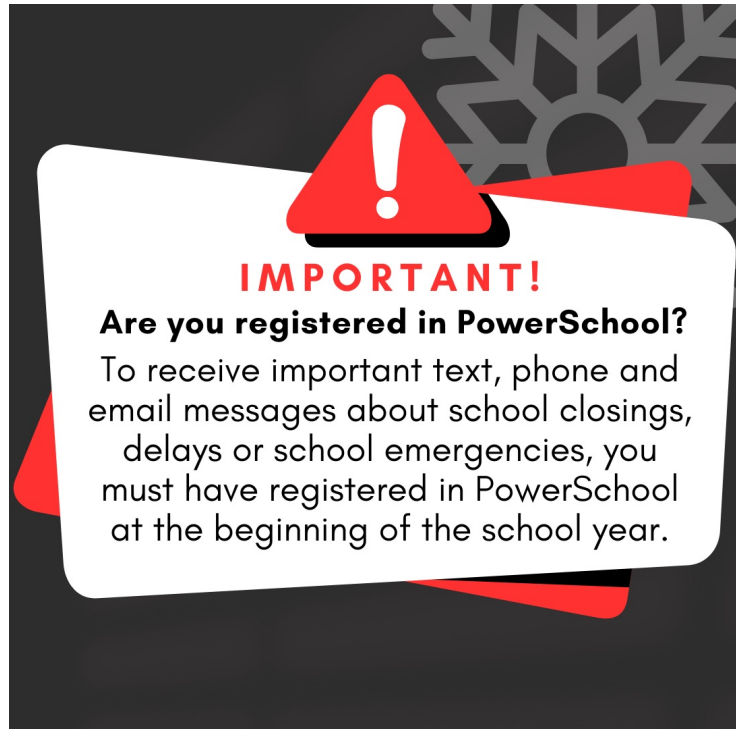


School Closings & Delays

In the event of a school closing or delay, Bishop Chatard will communicate with families through the following ways:

For two-hour delays or cancellations, our goal is to notify parents and families by 6:00 am. If there is a decision to delay, we will continue to monitor the condition of our surrounding roads.

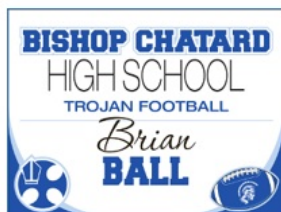
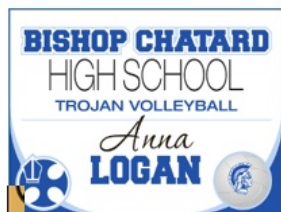


Class of 2029 - Application Deadline is December 5
