

  - You are concerned about the experience your student is having in one of his/her classes




#### Ben Reilly -Assistant Principal Student Services

  - You are concerned about the safety, security, and/or health of your student
  - You are looking for a fantastic lasagna recipe



### Jamie Marx - Director of Guidance (Grade 12)

- Leader of the Guidance Department (in charge of the academic, social, and emotional success of the student body)

### 7. How to Report an Absence

- 24 hours a day! We have a hot line number (317-251-1451 ext. 5505)!
  - parent/guardian name
  - Name of student & their class
  - Whether the student will be late, absent or dismissed early
  - The reason for the late arrival, absence or early dismissal
  - A telephone number where the parent may be reached between 9am-noon
- If a student is absent from school because of illness or an emergency, a parent/ guardian is required to notify the school office before 8am on the day the student is not in school
- Parents will be notified by 10am if their student is not present and we have not received a call-in

### 2. Ticket to Play




- Two forms needed (both found on our website: <u>bishopchatardathletics.org/</u> <u>physicals</u>).
