Long Term School Closure eLearning Q& A for Students

An eLearning day allows for instruction and learning to continue for a student *at home* in the event of an unexpected loss of a regularly scheduled school day.

It is your responsibility to follow the directions and course material teachers have posted in Canvas.

Ok, so I am at home...what am I expected to do?

You must log in to Canvas everyday. Check your teacher's Canvas page.

What's next?

You are responsible for all assignments in your classes that are scheduled for each day. All teachers will post all learning objectives, course content and the attendance form in Canvas by 9 a.m.

How will my teachers take attendance?

Teachers will be taking attendance via a Canvas quiz.

You **are required** to complete an attendance form for <u>each class</u>. Failure to do so will result in being marked unexcused for that particular class and work submitted will not receive credit.

Will my work be graded?

Yes.

All student work will be graded and recorded in Powerschool. You are required to submit all coursework as defined by your teachers.

When is my work due?

Work is due at the date and time that is defined by the teacher.

What if I have a question?

All teachers will be available for questions via a Canvas discussion board during office hours from 9:00-11:00 and 1:00-3:00. The preferred mode of communication for an immediate teacher response should be this discussion board. There will be a delayed response if you communicate with teachers via email. Teachers will do their best to respond to an email within 24 hours.
