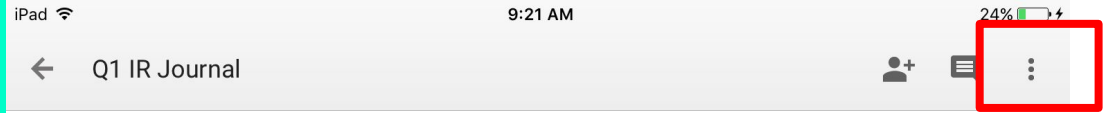

IN GOOGLE DOCS

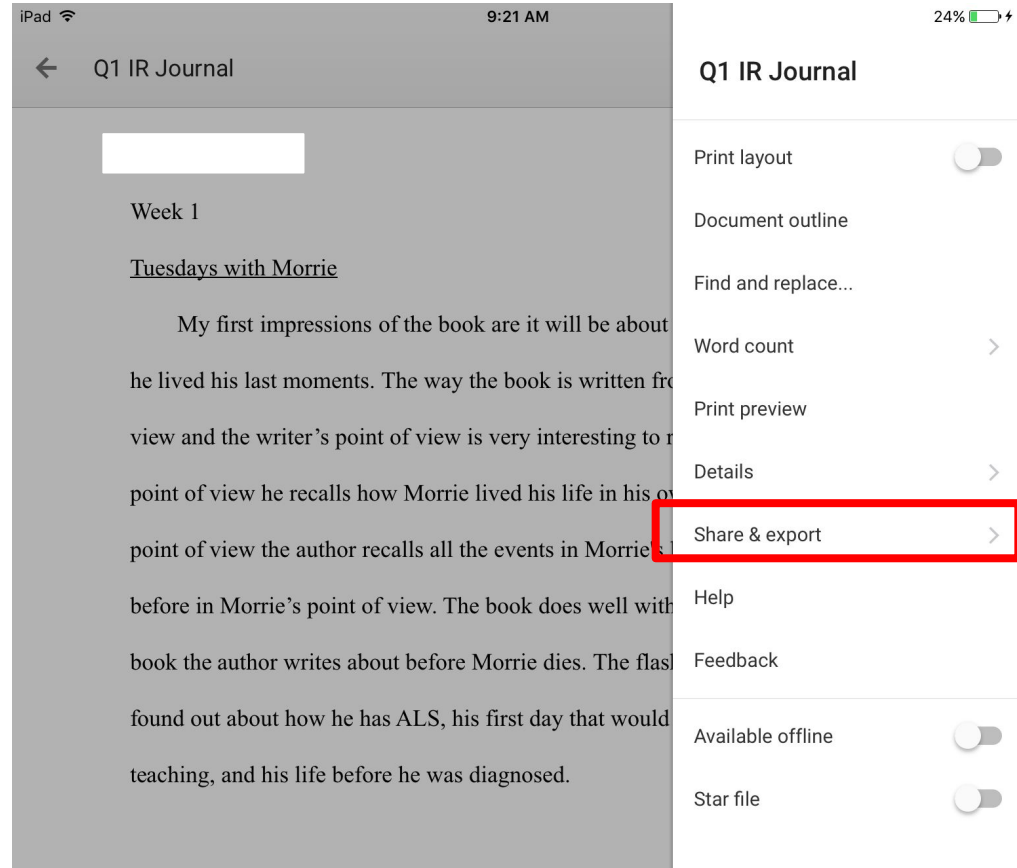

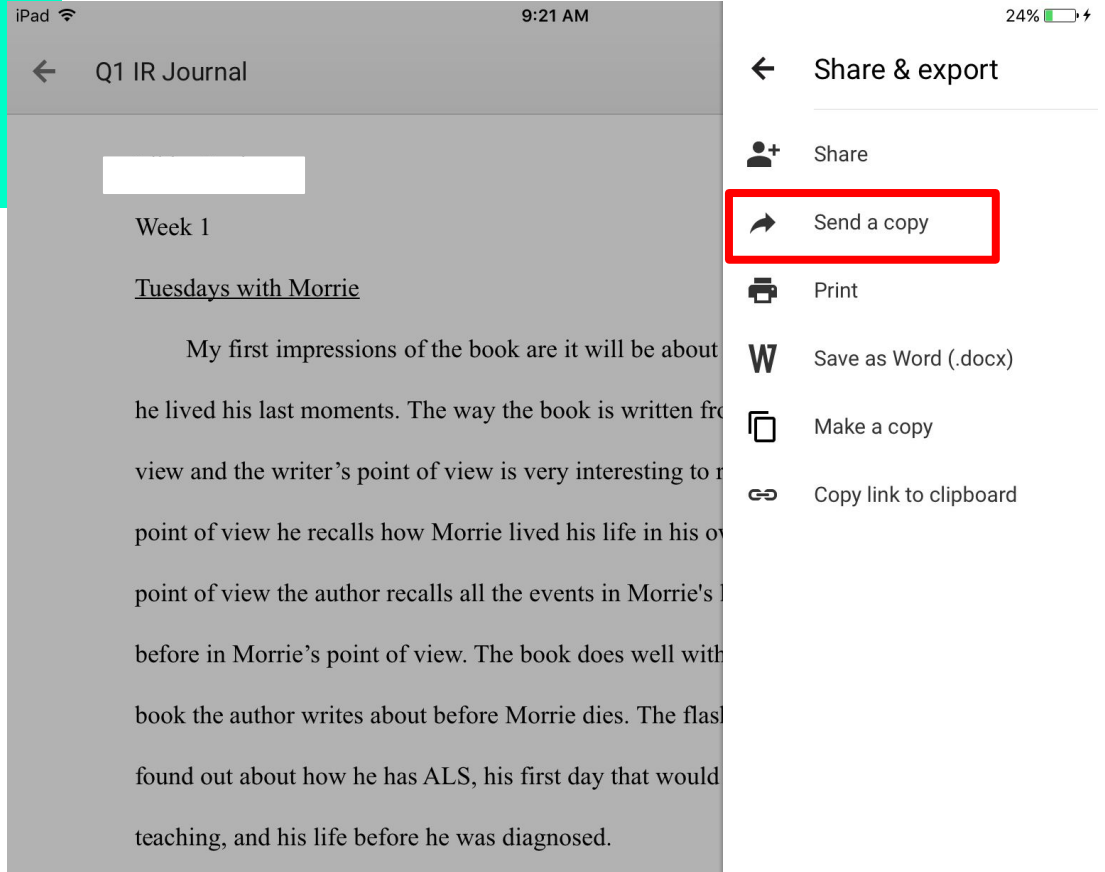
Tuesdays with Morrie
