SAT Synchronous eLearning Day Questions and Answers for Students

What is the purpose of a synchronous eLearning Day?

An eLearning day allows for instruction and learning to continue for a student *at home* in place of a regularly scheduled in-person school day.

Ok, so I am at home...what am I expected to do?

To begin learning, log into Canvas at the set time each course is scheduled and find the Google Meet link on the course homepage. We will follow this schedule:

How will my teachers take attendance?

Teachers will take attendance at the start of each virtual class period. Be on time for class. You will be marked absent if you are not present for your class on Google Meet.

Will my work be graded?

Yes.

All student work will be graded and recorded in PowerSchool. You are required to submit all coursework as defined by your teacher. Be prepared to have work to complete after the class session is over.

When is my work due?

Work is due at the date and time as defined by the teacher. If you are a junior in a mixed-grade class, you will be responsible for work missed but will have an extension and all work will be due by Friday, March 3rd. If you are a junior in an all-junior class, you will not meet or be responsible for any work from the SAT School Day.

How should I *prepare* for a synchronous eLearning Day?

- If you do not have wifi access at home, please notify the Tech counter immediately.
- Be certain you know how to access Canvas from home.
- Check your iPad. *Is it charged? Is it operating correctly?* See the Tech counter if you need help.
- Make sure you know where to locate the Google Meet link in Canvas for each course.
- Review the daily schedule and be prepared to log in to class on time. Your school day will start at 7:50 am and end at 11:55 am. Remember, you may have work to complete after class time is over.

Are you required to have your camera on?

- Each individual teacher will determine if they prefer to have the camera on or off.
- Be prepared for teachers to request the camera on. Make sure to dress appropriately and be seated in an appropriate space that will allow you to properly participate in class.
