Academics/Guidance

- Total Courses offered: 125
- AP Courses offered: 20; Dual Credit Courses offered: 4
- Honors Courses offered: 22
- BCHS received Indiana's Advanced Placement Achievement Award, placing in the top 3% of Indiana high schools. (Award recognized that 42% of BC Class of 2018 grads received a 3 or higher on an AP exam.)

- Graduation rate: 99%
- 134 members of the Class of 2019 — 80% of the senior class — graduated from Bishop Chatard with college credit earned through either AP or Dual Credit classes. The average number of college credits earned by these students: 10.76
- 38% of the seniors who were enrolled in the Academic Support Program earned an Academic Honors Diploma.
- Graduates earning Summa Cum Laude distinction: 13
- Graduates earning Academic Honors Diplomas: 61%
- Graduates pursuing college education: 93%
- Scholarship & grant dollars earned by Class of 2019: over \$20.8 million — Averaging nearly \$125,000 per student
