

## Senior Directed One-Acts

## Important information for this year:

- Mr. Cockrum will make the final determination as to who will direct. That will be based upon achievements, dependability, trustworthiness, and preparation as exhibited by your answers on the form below.
- Deadline to submit this form is Friday, October 4, 2019
- Auditions are set for Tuesday, October 29, 2019 immediately after school.
- Performances will be Saturday, December 7, 2019 time TBD based on number of plays selected.
- All primary directors are expected to be at the auditions, they can not send someone in their place.
- All shows MUST have an audition. There is no pre-casting before auditions.
- Rehearsals: The director must turn in a rehearsal schedule before the first rehearsal for approval. The theatre will be reserved so every director gets a fair amount of rehearsal time.
- Mr. Cockrum reserves the right to cancel the performance of any one-act play that does not meet the basic standards of stage-worthiness
- All plays must be edited for content and language. Mr. Cockrum will confer with each individual director about this matter.
- There may be 1 or 2 Directors per show. You are the director of your show and therefore must do the bulk of the work. If this is not what I see, your show will be pulled.
- All shows need to be approximately 20 minutes or less. Special permission must be obtained for any director wishing to direct a show that exceeds this limit. Any show not following this rule will be pulled.
