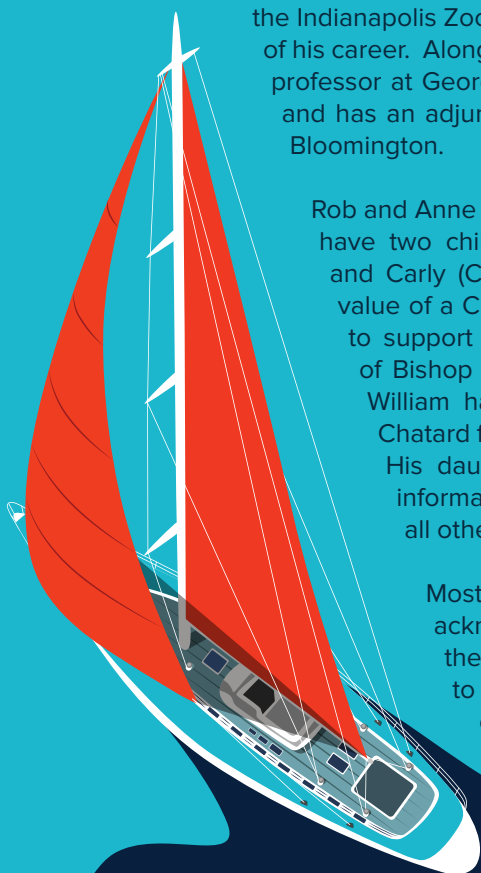


MEET OUR CHATARD-A-BRATION YACHT ROCK CHAIR
