Director's Note: Holly Stults

There are few things quite as recognizable as the Addams Family theme song and the iconic snaps that everyone performs when they hear it. The recent Netflix series Wednesday has brought this macabre family to light with a new generation of fans. Prior to that, there were several films, but this kooky family made their television debut in 1964 with a series that lasted two years. The musical opened on Broadway in April of 2010 featuring Nathan Lane as Gomez and Bebe Neuwirth as Morticia and has remained at the top of the list of most produced shows by high schools in the United States for the past 5 years. Regardless of when or how you were introduced to The Addams Family, it all goes back to creator and cartoonist. Charles Addams who produced standalone singlepanel comics published in the New Yorker beginning in 1938.

The story of this delightfully dark and twisted family has entertained audiences and readers for years but under the layers of these unusual characters are individuals who find themselves attempting to navigate a number of normal challenges: dishonesty: fear of change: children growing up: meeting your partner's family for the first time: wooing the moon---okay. maybe that last one is not so "normal".

As we look through this gothic lens of the Addams Family. who on the outside seem so very different. we see how much we have in common with them. This seemingly dysfunctional family dynamic is one filled with love. understanding. and tolerance for the uniqueness of others. The propensity for the peculiar isn't merely tolerated-it's celebrated! For within our peculiarities. our true radiance shines! Thank you for supporting theatre and the performing arts at Bishop Chatard and in any space where creativity is encouraged and celebrated.

May you. as Uncle Fester does. embrace the unknown and find your bliss as you join us and become a part of our crazy. unique. and loving family!




