
**Regon Brenner (Fishers Jr. High) – Assistant Crew Head (Makeup)**



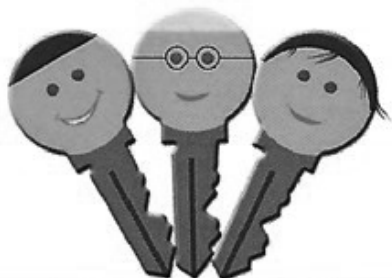
