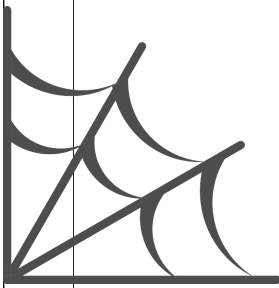

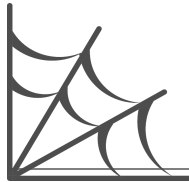

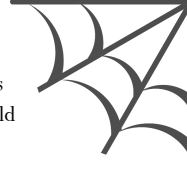
Addy Monger (Immaculate Heart of Mary): Goose/Crew Co-head (Props)

Sam Kennedy (St. Simon): Assistant Crew Head (Lights)

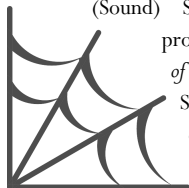

Christian Croddy (Lumen Christi): Townsperson

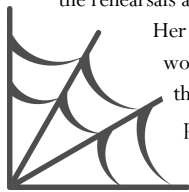

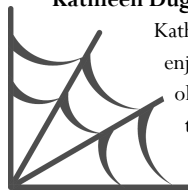
Rachel Cavender (Sts. Francis and Clare): Third Fairgoer

Victoria Nicholas (Christ the King): Townsperson

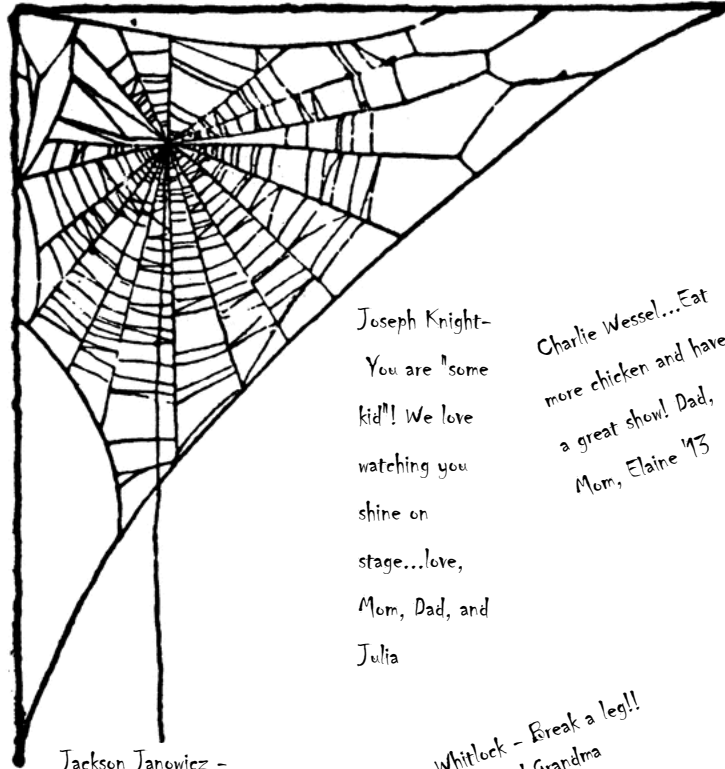
